Aim:	To explore OR nurses NTS outside CRM
Design:	Delphi technique
Data:	Qualitative data from round 2 of Delphi survey (n=96)
Data analysis:	Inductive thematic analysis



Non-technical skills

Non-technical skills are 'the cognitive, social, and personal recourse skills that complement technical skills and contribute to safe and efficient task performance.'


